Ethnography Field School: 7-week, 8-credit program in one of three different ongoing ethnographic research projects: Sustainable Community Tourism Research; Contemporary Maya Cultures; and Health, Healing and Illness research project. Homestays available. Prior knowledge of Spanish language and anthropology is preferred.

Maya Language Immersion: 6-week, 6-8 credit program based on intensive language immersion conducted on-site in Maya speaking communities and families in Yucatán and Quintana Roo, México. Beginning-advanced levels and homestays available.

7-Day Spanish Language Courses: 1-week, 1-3 credit program to increase conversational proficiency. Multiple consecutive weeks and homestays available.

Teach English to Maya Children (SELT): 4-week, 6-credit program community action project teaching English as a second language.
